Online proposal submission - and beamtime allocation - neutron & photon together	10
Remote proposal submission - common format - check submission elsewhere - European experiment DB	6
Peer review process support - online and meeting support	9
Experiment scheduling - also by users - BAG administration	9

User access and travel management - badge, keys, guest house, hotel, travel (reimbursement)	8
Safety management - trainings - declarations, classification	8
Sample description and tracking - samples/substances DB - environment definition - European experiment DB	5
Publications tracking - ISI, SCOPUS, PubMed, RIS and Keynote integration - incl. "grey" literature	11
Experimental report submission	2

Reporting and statistics <ul style="list-style-type: none">- export functionality- user, beamline and publication data- EU reporting	7
Data and metadata management	2
General user information <ul style="list-style-type: none">- proposal/experiment status- news- surveys / satisfaction polls	3
Event (conferences & workshops) management	3
Data transfer interfaces to external systems (e.g. ERP)	1

Central contact and hotline	1
Banking and financial information ... to survive the crisis ☺	1

Non-functional Requirements

- Modular, extensible, simple and flexible (5 times)
- Clean separation between general and site specific requirements
- Fine grained authorization across facilities
- Excellent performance and high availability
- Workflow engine
- Common look & feel
- Data safety
